CODE OF CONDUCT - River District Farmers Market

The River District Farmers Market provides an opportunity for the sale of local farm produce, food products and artisan crafts. The primary purpose of the Code of Conduct is to ensure the market environment is enjoyable, safe and secure for the public, vendors, and all market participants.

As a vendor of the River District Farmers Market, I will:

1. Conduct myself in a courteous and respectful manner towards the public and all market participants;
2. Refrain from any behaviour that interferes with the rights or working/selling opportunities of other vendors;
3. Refrain from using language which is offensive, threatening, or intimidating to others;
4. Not participate in the market under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
5. Operate vehicles or equipment in a safe and responsible manner;
6. Respect and adhere to the Policies & Guidelines established by the River District Farmers Market.

A report of failure to comply with any component of the Code of Conduct or Policies & Guidelines will be assessed and investigated by the Market Manager and River District Staff. Violations of the Code, Policies, and Guidelines will result in disciplinary action appropriate to the severity of the violation. Such actions may include verbal and written warnings, suspension from market participation, and/or expulsion from the market.

By way of my initials on the Vendor Application Form, I indicate my understanding and acceptance with this Code of Conduct and the Policies & Guidelines of the River District Farmers Market and agree to comply with the intention of these documents.
